Rowing in a cold water environment has unavoidable risks, including but not limited to hypothermia and drowning. 2. Participating in rowing is physically demanding, including but not limited to: heavy lifting (boats, motors and weights), rowing, cold water immersion/survival swimming. Rowers are responsible for self testing and seeking medical advice before beginning if needed. 3. Rowers must adhere to boating regulations and all rules, by-laws and the Constitution of the Antigonish Rowing Club. 4. Fees must be paid in full before going out on the water. Fees paid to Antigonish Rowing Club will not be returned. 5.
