

## Coaching Opportunities for the 2010 Season, Halifax Rowing Club, Halifax, Nova Scotia

The Halifax Rowing Club invites applications from candidates interested in coaching at the HRC during the 2010 rowing season. Two positions are available: one Coach and one Assistant Coach/Program Administrator. Both positions are full time from early May through end of August (exact dates negotiable); part-time work may be available in September and October. Preference will be given to full-time students returning to post-secondary studies.

The Halifax Rowing Club promotes rowing as a lifelong sport for fitness, skill development, competition, fun and friendship. We row on the picturesque North West Arm of the Halifax Harbour and have approximately 125 members of all ages, including a very active junior program and an adaptive rowing program. Working in collaboration with the Head Coach these two positions will organize and teach Learn to Row and novice programs and participate in coaching both competitive and recreational rowers at the junior, senior and master's levels. The coaches will assist with regattas, boathouse and boat maintenance, and general organization of the Club including program registration.

Candidates for the Coach's position should have NCCP Level 2 or equivalent, or be working towards this. Candidates for the Assistant Coach position should have NCCP Level 1 or be working towards this certification. Candidates for both positions need both rowing and coaching experience, and have good organizational and communication skills. Special consideration will be given to individuals who have a proven aptitude for boat and boathouse maintenance and/or administrative skills. In addition the successful candidates will need a Boat Operator's Card, and current qualifications in First Aid and CPR before starting employment at HRC.
