

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY FOR COACHING AND ADMINISTRATIVE STAFF, 2008 SEASON, HALIFAX ROWING CLUB

Halifax Rowing Club is inviting applications from candidates interested in coaching at HRC and/or carrying out related duties during the 2008 rowing season. The club wishes to fill the equivalent of two full-time positions between May and September. In addition, some part time work may be available in September and October.

Duties may include coaching competitive and recreational masters rowers, as well as rowers in youth and adaptive rowing programs, organizing regatta entries, boathouse maintenance, organizing and mentoring learn-to-row and volunteer coaches, and registering new rowers.

Candidates should have completed or be working towards NCCP Level 1, have both rowing and coaching experience, and have good organizational and communications skills. In addition successful candidates will need a Boat Operator's Card, and current qualifications in First Aid and CPR before starting employment at HRC. Some boat maintenance skills would be desirable but are not essential.

The salary will be commensurate with experience. Persons with disabilities and visible minorities are encouraged to apply. Canadian citizens or permanent residents will be given preference, in accordance with Immigration Canada requirements.
