Job Posting: Junior Rowing Coach

General Overview:

North Star Rowing Club is located on the base of Lake Banook. It offers rowing programs for youth (age 13-21), seniors (age 21-27), and masters (age 27+) that develops athletes who compete on the local, provincial and national and international levels. Our members and graduates have achieved medals in both World and Olympic competition. The Club also offers a “learn to row” program for both youth and adults. Recreational rowing is a relatively new concept that has become extremely popular and a great way to keep in shape and have a great time with friends and co-workers.

The coach will work along side senior coaches and under the direction of the head coach. Development and revision of curriculum within the Masters, Juniors and Learn to Row programs is one of the components in being a Junior Coach. He/She must ensure that athletes adhere to all safety guidelines on and off the water. He/She must adhere to the Coaching Code of Ethics.

Specific Responsibilities:

- To coordinate and instruct Learn to Row, and Recreational programs;
- To develop, implement training programs for the Masters and Junior program;
- To assist in the coordination of all aspects of the NSRC, which including regatta registration
- To assist in the maintenance of the boathouse and club equipment;
- To provide leadership to youth and other members of the club

Qualifications:

- Must be fulltime post-secondary student returning to studies in September
- NCCP Coaching Certificate Level I or II or acquiring certification
- Motor Boat Safety Certification
- Current First Aid Course
- Excellent Swimming Ability
- Excellent Interpersonal Skills
- Highly Organized

Work Schedule:

- 35 Hours/ week
- May-September and possibly into October
- Attendance at regattas
- Hour breakdown:
 - o 8 am – 11am
 - o 5 pm – 9 pm

Remuneration:

Salary will be \$11.00 per hour. Transportation and accommodation expenses related to out-of-town regattas will be partially covered by the NSRC.
